Day 3:

(Note, each new doc includes all the prior days, so if you miss one, you don't miss anything. But don't wait to start following along until I'm done, follow along and do the work yourself so that when I'm done, you have built a business at the same time).

So it starts with day 1, then continues to the current day . . .

Day 1:

I've created a squeeze page and a sales page when someone opts in:

squeeze page:

The next step is promoting these pages in a new niche, and quickly.

Organic traffic takes time, so for this project I'm not using it now.

PPC advertising might be good, but I still want something even faster.

So to build this fast, I'm going to buy solo ads.

Today I spent my time working on this creating the squeeze page, finishing up the sales page and adding in the download and payment routing, etc., and spent some time collecting solo ad sources for the niche.

Here's what I did:

To find solo ads, I went to yahoo and typed in "self help solo ads" and got this:

Then I searched for “self improvement solo ads” (can you imagine how many more topics you could put in to find targeted solo ads? Or use google in addition to yahoo?)

Now, it's not necessary to email before you buy, but frankly since I'm doing this project for all the world to see, I don't want to buy a solo mailing and then it doesn't mail for 3 weeks, I really want to buy solos that will mail in the next few days.

Then once I emailed everyone on those lists, and haven't gotten a response back yet, I thought I would check the Warrior Forum for some solo ad opportunities just to test a few, here is the search terms I used in advanced search:

(note, I'm not counting on these solos to be great, they are probably im leads, not self-help leads, but want to test a few just to see. Note also: testing is key, if you don't test and know which solos provide what ROI, you won't be able to scale up)

obviously there are many many more, and if you are serious about this, you can find many many more.

Now, at this point, I can't do much more until someone writes back, I buy an ad, then I can give you what I put in the email, and so on.

Another GREAT way to find solos is to just get on people's lists in your market, then write them and ask if they would consider selling you a mailing to their list.

Now, another GREAT way to find people who will mail for you is to find people who are mailing for other people.

One way is to get on tons of lists, then see if people are mailing for other people.

Another way is to find the giveaways in your niche and participate. Two things happen: 1) you get subscribers when you actively participate and 2) you can contact EVERY PERSON who is advertising a free gift in the giveaway about doing a mailing for you.

Here's the thing, you KNOW they are willing to mail offers, because they are mailing to be a part of the giveaway!

Ok, I've received 2 responses so far, these are for mailing on the 11th and the 13th, so won't get immediate results.

Within the next 24 hours I should have some folks able to mail sooner -

And start putting results here.

So, next steps:

getting an adserver/tracking solution (I'll show you a few options and the one I choose in the next installment

buying solo ads

mailing the offers

tracking the results

then rinse and repeat

also, I'm planning to add an upsell to the front end offer - and of course I'll show you that as well when I do it

Day 2:

I have received about 6 responses from solo ad providers who are able/willing to mail soon - but many after the beginning of next week.

I plan to buy all of them today, but it might be a few days before results start coming in.

But before I can buy any of them, I have to set up an ad tracking campaign

Yesterday I spent some time looking at different options, here are the primary ones I looked at:

The key thing I needed was that I could track 2 conversion goals, and the folks at clickmeter told me I could, so I signed up with them for the \$29/month solution (it gives me 25,000 events per month). I believe an event is a visit, a click, or a conversion.

That should be enough for this test. And this will allow me to test their servers and their service.

So next I'll set up the ad tracking campaign in clickmeter, then I can begin to buy solo ads (no sense in buying ads until I can give the solo ad providers the link to send to.)

Also, perhaps you are thinking, why not just create different pages, etc., or just use visualwebsiteoptimizer, which you already pay for?

The key is I want it to be simple, so that I have just one page for all visitors (in the campaign) to come to. And I can use visualwebsiteoptimizer to split test on that one page. Hence an adserver.

And why not visualwebsiteoptimizer? Primarily because it is much more expensive for the same traffic, PLUS - it seems much more complicated to set up varying tracking links (if not impossible), I sent them a message about the same time as I sent one to voluum and clickmeter, and have not received a response. (Also: voluum is about 4x cheaper, if I remember, than clickmeter - BUT they only allow tracking of ONE conversion goal, and I want 2: the optin AND the first sale.

That's all I've done on this today :-)

and it might be the beginning of next week before I can do the next step (which is creating a tracking campaign, then buying the solos and writing the solo ad).

I was hoping this would go faster . . . but this is probably good, too, because you can see that things don't always go smooth even for me!!

Day 3:

The first thing I did in this business is set up my first clickmeter tracking link (took about 2 mins)

Then I bought the first solo ad:

I bought the 300 click version, this will give me something solid to test with

I don't like to buy the biggest package even if the price is much better per click because a lot of times when someone is selling clicks their bigger packages take multiple mailings or they might even buy traffic from somewhere else to meet the number.

So your lead quality tends to be a lot better if you just buy a smaller package, one they can get all your clicks in one mailing.

Now, because this is my first solo mailing for this offer, I haven't written a swipe yet, so when I bought the ad and sent the seller my transaction id and the tracking link, I asked him:

I don't have a swipe written for this yet . . . would you be willing to write something that tends to resonate with your list, and just copy me on it ?

This will allow me to allow him to write my first swipe (which will likely be strong, as its in his interest to get me as many clicks as fast as possible)

Hopefully tomorrow I will get to buying the others (there are about 3 others who have responded personally)

keep in mind, with this, I'll get 300 clicks, and hopefully about 100 subscribers -

so just a few more mailings like this and I'll be into a zone where I can really start seeing test results from the upsell

Notice that what I've just done took about 20 minutes.

Now, this is just one of several projects I worked on today.

Each project I work on I use a "what is the next thing I need to do on this project today" principle for determining what to do next.

Or you can ask the question: what is the most valuable use of my time (today), or (on this project) etc.

So it's like for each of my projects, I treat it like a "day" even if it's only 10 minutes
